1930. He was particularly interested in the control of cancer, and had made special investigations into certain types of plastic surgery, involving the management of contraindications following burns.

He was a member of the American Medical Association, the Durham-Orange County Medical Society, and the Presbyterian Church; and was one of the most popular members of the medical school faculty.
