Names of Duke as Trinity Are in
Office Files

Public Relations and Alumni Affairs, a department of the university, about which most students have a dis-
tinguished opinion, was described by Henry B. Dwire speaking recently morning.

Included in its files are approximately 16,000 alumni and addresses of Duke and Trinity. The records have been kept since 1905. The names of all the present students are also on the department's office.

Of the 16,000, only 5,000 men are active as alumni and 2,000 women are active as alumnae. There are 7,000 men taken up residence in every state in the Union and in every country in North America.
