Those who truly meet the test will discover that Dr. Hopkins was right when he said that as man has always triumphed before, so will man inevitably triumph again.

FORD SHIPS SAIL THE SEVEN SEAS



Down to the sea in Ford ships go millions of tons of shipping. The Ford docks berth one of the largest industrial fleets in the world.
