Duke Instructor Issued Patent

Electric Device to Be Manufactured Soon

Russell Ranson, instructor in electrical engineering, has been issued a patent involving simplified methods of controlling, by regulators, the output voltage of electric generators.

The invention is being considered of great significance, for heretofore closely regulated output voltages have been attained only by means of complicated and costly devices.

The Ranson device is to be manufactured by the Clark Contoller company of Cleveland, Ohio, and shortly Mr. Ranson will become director of the electronic research and development laboratories of that company. Mr. Ranson, a Duke graduate, is a native of Charlotte.

Says Secretary of Air

May Be Appointed Soon
"I believe that a new cabinet member will be appointed very soon, a Secretary of the Air," said Lieutenant Keenan of Hope field, Fort Bragg, N. C., while lecturing to the members of the Duke Flying club in the "Possibilities of College Students in Aviation" last Friday night in Gray.

"Not only is there a great opportunity for college men in the field of aviation," he said, "but there are places for the co-eds who are interested in aviation. Young women are needed in the production of planes. In the field of design they are practically indispensable. You would be surprised at the number of young women being employed in the large aircraft corporations today."

He stated that at the present time the government is planning to add 6,000 new planes to the air corps, 4,000 new pilots, and to expand the personnel to 25,000 men.

At the beginning of his lecture, he explained that the government had canceled his notes very strictly, which he added, shows the tense feeling in the army today.
